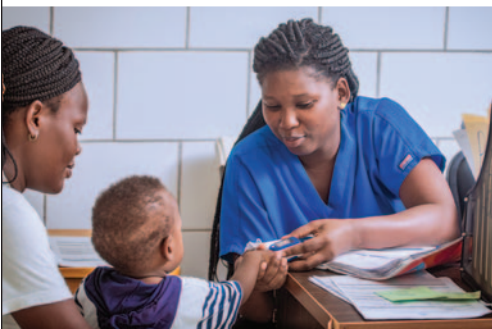

## TOGETHER WE THRIVE, THANKS TO YOU



**IN THE FIRST HALF OF 2024, NOVA has experienced remarkable growth and success. The construction of a new medical clinic and the addition of Dr. Anthonika Titus as Director of Operations have led to a 150% increase in activity since December 2023.**

Anthonika's outreach to community leaders and the promotion of NOVA's hypertension clinic, along with new cervical and prostate cancer screening programs, have significantly contributed to this growth. Twenty-five percent of our patient volume is made up by new patients. Additionally, during a flu-like epidemic in May, NOVA treated over 1,400 patients, setting a new record.

Currently, NOVA provides care for an average of 1,000 patients per month, resulting in not only an increased number of physician consultations but also increased laboratory tests and pharmacy dispensations. To manage

this workload, we have extended the hours of their part-time doctor and hired a part-time lab technician.

Looking ahead, NOVA needs to hire a third doctor, preferably a pediatrician, and an additional nurse to continue meeting the community's needs. We are calling for donations to support this expansion, thereby ensuring we can keep providing essential medical care to the people of Cavallon.

NOVA's journey over the past six months highlights our vital role and relationships in the community and our commitment to growth and excellence in healthcare. ■

NOVA Hope for Haiti is proud to be fully operating out of our newly rebuilt clinic. With five exam rooms, a lab and pharmacy, and indoor and outdoor patient waiting areas, our staff is able to provide quality primary care for infants to the elderly in Cavaillon.
